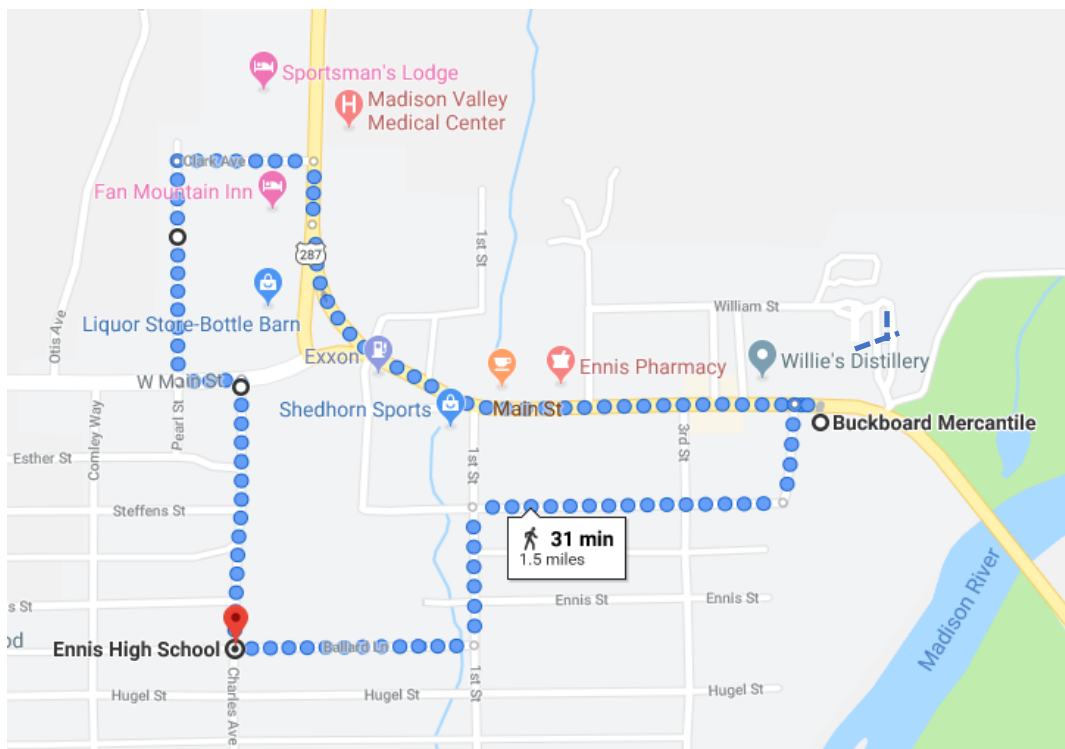

Meeting Location: Ennis High School Parking Lot

Parade Route: From the High School to Pearl Street in front of Town Hall. Then East on Charles St. and right on Highway 287 in front of Nursing Home. Floats will go down on the curve to Main Street and turn right AFTER the Buckboard Mercantile. After wrapping around the brick building, go onto Steffens and continue onto 3rd St, right onto Hugel, right onto Charles Ave, and end up back in the High School parking lot (this is a new route as of 2019). Please refer to the image below! There will be signs to turn. Bigger map is on the last page.



Restrooms: Ennis High School Lobby

Entry Numbers: All Parade entries require a number. You will be assigned an entry number when you register and will be given the number when you check in on the 4th. The number must be fastened to the left side of the float/horse/car/motorcycle etc. It is important that the judges and announcers can see your number at the former First Madison Valley Bank location. Your entry number does NOT indicate position; it merely identifies you with a description and name.

Parade Order: Your Parade entry number does not indicate position. Parade volunteer staff will place entries in order based on safety and interest.

Judging Criteria: The judges are on the balcony at the former First Madison Valley Bank location.

NO STOPPING TO PERFORM ALLOWED.

100 points total

1. Theme – does it follow the parade theme - All Roads Lead to Ennis? (25 points)
2. Originality – is it unique, imaginative, creative? (25 points)

- 3. Complexity – design detail and effort put forth (25 points)
- 4. Patriotic (25 points)

Selection of Judges – The judges are usually selected from RV Village. They are seasonal tourists that do not have any ties to the area.

Prize: \$50 Chamber cash to Best Local Entry and to Best Out-of-Town Entry. \$25 Chamber cash to all other winning categories.

Safety: Please be conscious of vehicles, horses, and children – they don't mix well. Please do not throw candy or trinkets. Also, no super soakers water guns splashing at the crowd. An adult must accompany children under 12.
